There are calls for the Federal Government to reverse funding cuts to community legal centres, which are being swamped by an increase in domestic violence cases. Community Legal Centres Queensland's James Farrell says centres have to turn away almost half of the cases they receive across all legal issues. Federal Attorney-General George Brandis blames Labor for the problem, saying Labor only allocated money for CLCs until 2017 while it was still in power.
