

According to the Qld Community Legal Centre, there has been a 600% increase in people seeking help for domestic violence support over the last five years. Last year, community legal centres in Qld took on more than 4,400 domestic violence cases. There was also a significant increase in the number of people looking for information or basic support in the period. James Farrell, Director, Community Legal Centres Queensland, says they have assisted more than 60,000 people last financial year.
