

Less help for women fleeing domestic violence under federal funding cuts

A looming 30% reduction in federal funding to community legal centres is predicted to force cuts and closures to services assisting some of the nation's most vulnerable citizens.

Community Legal Centres Queensland says nearly two in five people who reach out for help are already being turned away, and tens of thousands more Australians will suffer under a federal funding cut from July.
