Men found guilty of homosexuality offences in Queensland before the 1990's will be able to have their convictions expunged under new laws passed by State Parliament. Consensual adult gay sex was decriminalised in the State in January 1991 but convictions before that date have remained on criminal records. Executive Director at the LGBTI Legal Service, Emile McPhee, says the laws passed overnight are historic.
