## **OUR SERVICES**

Our Clinic is staffed by registered migration agents, legal practitioners, academics and Bond law students who provide free legal advice to vulnerable and financially disadvantaged non-citizens that wish to remain in Australia legally.

The Clinic offers immigration information and advice to:

- persons seeking asylum in Australia on refugee and asylum seeker law.
- persons recognised as having refugee status who are seeking to sponsor family members to Australia.
- persons who are victims of domestic violence and who hold a temporary partner visa in Australia.
- vulnerable international students.
- vulnerable members of the community regarding their visa and visa eligibility (and assistance, if eligible).
- the wider community in the following areas (basic advice only): skilled independent visa, skilled sponsor visa, student visa, graduates visa, partners visa, and parent and other family visas.

## WHEN AND WHERE

The Clinic operates on specific Wednesday evenings during University semester periods. It will operate at Bond University Faculty of Law from 5.30 – 7.30pm on Wednesdays 14<sup>th</sup> February 28<sup>th</sup> February, 14<sup>th</sup> March and the 28<sup>th</sup> March.
