Media coverage summary

Understanding the Impact of Phone and Internet Issues in Queensland report

About the survey

With the Telecommunications Industry Ombudsman managing complaints and dispute resolution, and Community Legal Centres Queensland in a leading advocacy and legal advice role, both organisations work directly with those affected by phone and internet problems.

Community legal sector workers in the state were surveyed for an understanding of the issues their clients are experiencing.

Those surveyed are all community legal sector workers in Queensland. The survey was completed between 19 February, 2018 and 5 March, 2018.

The survey looked at the frequency of phone and internet problems arising, the barriers for consumers in complaining, the most common phone and internet issues, and what could help consumers with their problems.

Key messages

- The Understanding the Impact of Phone and Internet Issues in Queensland report surveyed 137
 Queensland community legal sector workers on their experiences of working with their clients
 over the last two years.
- 2. The survey results found almost half (48%) of Queensland's community legal sector workers have reported hearing about a phone or internet problem from clients every week.
- 3. The most common issues highlighted in the survey were being unable to pay for a phone or internet service, increasing debt, and not enough money to pay bills.
- 4. The report shows issues with phone and internet services often led to subsequent problems for residential consumers and small businesses including mental health issues, debt and a suspension of their services.

Media summary

In total, 474 media reports mentioned the Telecommunications Industry Ombudsman and Queensland survey between 8 March and 11 March 2018, reaching a total national audience of 7.99 million (7,990,287).

Print, radio and online coverage included two print articles with an audience of 148,903, 460 radio mentions with an audience of 7.83 million and 12 online news articles reaching an audience of 6,484.

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Spike in phone woes

Customers engage lawyers to solve issues

QUEENSLANDERS unsure about where to take their phone and internet problems are turning to the community legal sector to complain.

According to a new report by the industry's Ombudsman revealed today, almost half of all community legal workers hear telecommunications complaints every week.

At the same time, the Telecommunications Industry Ombudsman has been forced to

increase staff by more than a third over the past two years to cope with the rising complaints.

Grievances about the National Broadband Network more than doubled in Queensland last year, while overall complaints rose by almost half.

"It's a wakeup call for the industry," said Ombudsman Judi Jones.

"We shouldn't need to continually employ more staff." The release of today's report follows a News Corp revelation that Queensland is receiving one of the lowest rollouts of the superior allfibre NBN.

The report surveyed 137 Queensland community legal sector workers and found:

- The majority said their clients didn't know how to complain about their phone and internet issues.
- Almost half of their clients said they experienced phone and internet service problems every week.
- The most common issue was increasing debt and an inability to pay for a service.

Ms Jones said it was crucial for people to try to resolve their issues with their service provider first.

"If the complaint is unresolved, they should then go to the Ombudsman. We are free and accessible and our job is to take the place of consumers," she said.

"Phones and the internet are central in our lives and the message from Queensland's Community Legal Sector Workers is don't feel you're on your own. In tough times, mounting problems have a domino effect, one problem leads to another, and on to another."
