Dear Premier,

Parliamentary inquiry into serious crime

Queensland Association of Independent Legal Services Inc (**QAILS**) welcomes your recent announcement that the Parliamentary Legal Affairs and Community Safety Committee will conduct an inquiry into serious crime in Queensland.

Our 33 member community legal centres assist victims of crime understand their legal rights and navigate legal systems. Our members also act for people who commit/are alleged to have committed crimes, and understand the social and economic factors that contribute to people committing crime and entering the justice system. In our experience, it is common that people who commit crimes are often victims themselves, demonstrating the complexity of this issue.

Based on that experience, and our experience in parliamentary and statutory inquiries into various issues relating to the justice system, we write to respectfully provide our perspective on the terms of reference of the inquiry. Our preliminary suggestions are that the terms of reference for the inquiry should include investigating:

- the actual incidence of crime (reported and unreported) across Queensland by age, geography and crime type;
- the social and economic impact for victims of crime and their communities;
- the social and economic contributors to crime;
- the social and economic impacts of the serious crime of family and domestic violence;
- the types of sentence or response to offending that reduce further criminal activity and offending behaviours; and
- policies and strategies that reduce or prevent crime through proactively addressing the causes
 of crime, including policing practices and local and place-based initiatives, particularly programs
 that intervene early and prevent crime.
