



FPS

information about the

agreement in writing

and suggests she speak to Centrelink about how the co-living arrangement might affect her age pension.

The FPS worker refers Mary inhouse for social work and legal advice because she appears under pressure from her son and on the brink of making

a decision that may place her at risk of financial abuse.
