\$499,000 funding boost for community legal services in Hervey Bay

Hervey Bay residents are set to benefit from a \$499,000 cash injection for community legal services over the next five years.

Attorney-General and Minister for Justice Yvette D'Ath said the funding would ensure the ongoing provision of quality legal assistance services, delivered in the community to Hervey Bay residents.

"Queensland's community legal sector delivers vital services to thousands of Queenslanders," Mrs D'Ath said.

"Our community legal centres provide advice and assistance to some of the most vulnerable and disadvantaged people.

"This package is worth \$499,000 over five years and it will give Hervey Bay's community legal sector what it needs to continue its great work."

The organisation being funded is:

- Hervey Bay Neighbourhood Centre (\$499,000)

Mrs D'Ath said the Palaszczuk Government worked closely with the sector's peak body, Community Legal Queensland, on the Statewide funding package worth \$119 million over five years.

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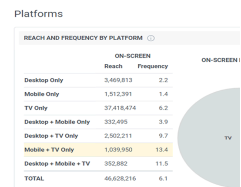
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
